Subject: Extension or otherwise of the validity of Central Orders dated 30.09.2014 in respect of Pulse, Edible Oils and Edible Oilseeds beyond 30.09.2015-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the Central Order S.O. 2559(E) dated 30.09.2014 which enables the State Governments/UT Administrations to impose stock limits and take effective steps for undertaking de-hoarding operations under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 in respect of Pulse, Edible Oils and Edible Oilseeds, is going to lapse on 30.09.2015.

2. The considered views of the States/UTs in this regard are required to be presented before the Cabinet for considering extension of the validity of the order by one year i.e. upto 30.09.2016.
3. The State Governments/UT Administration is, therefore, requested to furnish views/comments in the matter to this Department by 31.07.2015.
