G.S.R. 252.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the erstwhile Ministry of Civil Supplies, Consumer Affairs and Public Distribution Group "D" posts Recruitment Rules, 1991, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Multi Tasking Staff, Group 'C' posts in the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Consumer Affairs, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, (Department of Consumer Affairs) Multi Tasking Staff (Group 'C') posts Recruitment Rules, 2012:

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay/scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and pay band and grade pay/scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in

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
