

**MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION  
(Department of Consumer Affairs)  
New Delhi,**

**G.S.R.** – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the National Test House; Kolkata. (Junior Translator), Recruitment Rules, 2017, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Junior Translator in the National Test House, under the Department of Consumer Affairs, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, namely :-

**1. Short title and commencement.** – (1) These rules may be called the National Test House (Junior Translator) Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(2). They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. .

**2. Number of post, classification, level in the pay matrix.** – The number of post, its classification, level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, educational qualifications, etc.** – The method of recruitment, age-limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule. .

**4. Disqualification.** – No person, –

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or  
(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds, for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax.** – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary and expedient so to do, it may, by order and for the reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving.** – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time. in this regard.

Recognised Diploma or Certificate course in translation from Hindi to English & vice versa or Two years' experience of translation work from Hindi to English and vice versa in Central or State Government Office, including Government of India Undertaking.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Staff Selection Commission/Competent Authority in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The Qualification(s) regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the SSC/Competent Authority in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection, the SSC/Competent Authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities

possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancy reserved for them.
